Thoughts and prayers are with those, known and unknown, for whom this is a difficult time of year, as well as celebrations with those for whom this will be a happy time of recognition of love and care.

Marking Mothering Sunday (14th March this year)

As well as the Benefice Zoom service from Gamlingay I will be visiting and recording a video in each church as we offer prayer and worship on this day. The churches will be open all day and a liturgy, useable individually, will be circulated with the Sunday service material, as well as some "clean" copies being available in church.

There are cards available in the churches and through some doors, which can be kept or returned, for prayer and celebration of someone (living or departed) who has been given care and through whom we have known God's love.
