Harvest Celebrations

Looking ahead

We have **All Saints and Memorial** season ahead of us. Halloween falls on a Sunday this year. The Church offers that Sunday as an option for celebrating All Saints, a major Church festival, so our 5th Sunday services will involve Benefice celebrations. The time of the morning service at Everton has not yet been fixed - 10am or 11.15am are the two options currently under consideration. Views welcome!

In the evening we are holding a Service of Light in Gamlingay which will be a short service focusing on the call to be Saints and to walk in the light. On this evening, when many will be celebrating the Eve of All Saints by dressing up as things of darkness, we will be concentrating on things of light, inviting people to bring candles and lanterns (especially maybe candles given at Baptism or Confirmation) to be lit symbolically.

That service will follow on from the Light Party for families at Gamlingay Church Hall. Details on that to follow. **Remembrance Sunday** falls on 14th November this year, more details on that next time. Discussions are underway for how this service can take place safely and be shared remotely. It will be hosted at St Mary's this year.

Advent Sunday: Looking further ahead, we shall be celebrating Advent Sunday (the start of the new Church Year) on 28th November with an authorising service for our ALMs, celebrating the service of our lay leaders.
