July 11th - Scything and Meadow Management Course

A good deal of the course was about the management of wild flowers, and that will be put into practice in all our churchyards.

Sunday 16th July

The Benefice service has been transposed to this day influenced by the fact of Norman and Hilary's Ruby Wedding which falls then - 40 years since making promises to one another 'in the sight of God and before this congregation here present' at All Saints, Polebrook. The service will take place as planned, as it is not just about Hilary and Norman, but intended as a celebration of family and relationships celebrating all forms of family and bearing in mind that sometimes people are missing, or things didn't work out as we'd hoped. This is particularly apt as Norman may not be there after all, though it is hoped to include him by Zoom, and there may still be some family visitors. SO - Do join us for lunch at the Church Hall afterwards, for a very informal buffet from 12 - 2pm. Thank you to everyone who has given notice of attendance. Some help setting up will be welcome and, most importantly, help clearing away afterwards will be useful.

Bishop Stephen's last service also takes place on this day at the Cathedral (apologies that this has been omitted from the Newsletter previously!). Unfortunately Hilary can't be there, but others could manage both the buffet at Gamlingay and the service in Ely - all are welcome as the Bishop lays his Staff on the cathedral altar and we all say God Bless and give thanks for his ministry among us. At Deanery Synod it was agreed to make a donation from the PCCs. Parishes can then ask people to give to their PCCs or direct to the Cathedral appeal.
