#### From Hilary:

It has been a particularly busy week with two more Gamlingay church funerals absorbing much of my attention and energy. I am hugely grateful to those who are both able and willing to work with me to enable the running of the churches in this Benefice, including those who help in thanking you! There has been quite a bit going on, as well as the funerals, since the last Newsletter was produced - see the parishes' individual news for that. Both parishes will have memorial-style services in early November, but arrangements are not finalised at this time.

#### Vacancy in See

I know this may not interest many, but I share here the process by which anyone can still be involved in finding the next Bishop of Ely. Bishop Dagmar, our Acting Bishop (appointed Bishop of Huntingdon soon after I arrived) is not eligible for this post according to the long-standing practice of not appointing the Acting Bishop. It is no reflection on the excellent job she is doing. Canon Paul Evans writes:

#### How: Zoom Webinar

You will, I hope, already be aware that there will be a public meeting regarding the process of appointing our next Bishop of Ely taking place on **Monday 30 October 2023 starting at 7pm**. This will take the form of a Zoom Webinar and we anticipate it will last roughly an hour – this timing will, as I am sure you will understand, depend on the number of questions raised either on the night or submitted in writing beforehand.

The Very Revd Mark Bonney, Dean of Ely and Chair of the <u>Vacancy in See Committee</u>, will be chairing the meeting, supported by members of the Vacancy in See Committee and Diocese of Ely staff. The webinar will start with an introduction from Stephen Knott, the Archbishops' Appointments Secretary, who will be joining us from Lambeth, before the 'floor' will be opened-up for questions and for attendees to make their representations, should they wish. You would be most welcome to submit a question regarding the appointment of the new Bishop, or any observation, in advance of the webinar by sending an email to Sheena Bridgman via <u>sheena.bridgman@elydiocese.org</u> before **10am on 30 October 2023**. This will assist in ensuring the questions can be collated, considered, and answered by the relevant officers on the night. If you submit a question, please include your name and that of the church where you worship (plus the name of your Deanery if you know it).

## **NEWS FROM EVERTON**

**Gift Day -** the final total reported to PCC is £1,500, a sum for which we are hugely grateful. The lower figure than on previous occasions reflects the loss of two or three significant contributors, as well as times in which people are having to think carefully about charitable donations as their disposable income reduces.

**Barnabas Oley** – the charity's postponed meeting will now take place next Tuesday morning.

**Churchyard Plan** – this is being updated with advice being sought from Beds, Cambs and Northants Wildlife Trust. When finalised it will be widely publicised.

The church building is still closed.

**Churchyard** – this needs some attention to prepare for the winter.

Alec and others were present at last week's Council meeting where support for the rewiring project was given. Church reps will be part of the discussion in November with the contractors, and plans for collaborative volunteer work are being prepared with the Meadow management team.

**Harvest Donations** for Niassa Diocese amounted to  $\pm 60$ , making a total for Niassa from January 2023 of  $\pm 290$ .

**Memory Lane** meets next week (24th) with either a Tai Chi session or Halloween/All Saints theme (or possibly a combination of these!). A Christmas-themed tea dance will follow in November on the 21st led by our friends from Band of Ukes.
