### Unsolicited pubilicity

I have spotted some material left on the table in church which has been put there by someone not part of our church. It purports to be from a Christian organisation, but it is not one affiliated with our church and I'd like to enlist your help in making sure that visitors to church don't find things there that are nothing to do with us or anyone we have proper links with. I have taken the envelopes out, checked the content and would advise people not to make contact with the organisation concerned. Although it looks to be a bona fide Christian charity (Revival Ministries International) it is a huge American organisation, and therefore I'm a little suspicious. We have plenty of local ministry that we can check up on - if anyone is looking for something a bit different from the Anglican offering. GBC, with whom we work, is a much better option.

We have also been contacted by 'Good News for Everyone' - Huntingdon branch - this is what used to be Gideons - again an American organisation which used to do an important ministry distributing Bibles through an exclusively male network. There has been a split in the organisation over the inclusion of women, and as a female priest I have found them difficult to work with.

I do not oppose, indeed I welcome, anything that brings the Good News of Jesus Christ to people. Seeking to revive faith and help people to live Christian lives is part of my own caring, however I do advise some caution. We need to be (as Jesus says) 'wise as serpents and innocent as doves' in dealing with ways in which Scripture and the Gospel can be misused and resources diverted to ends we would not ourselves wish to be part of.
