We are offering free cake and drinks to our churchyard volunteers at that, as a token of thanks.

The Sunday of Pentecost (Whitsunday) will see a Treasure Hunt at Gamlingay, thank you to Amanda for arranging the clues. Anyone who has ideas and talents to offer for fundraising for our churches, please make contact (see the list at the end of this letter for who and where).

As the weather continues to be cold again, despite trees coming into leaf it doesn't feel very spring-like. Apologies to those who feel the cold as churches prove hard to keep warm.

In this Benefice we are joining with churches across the Diocese and the country in looking at ways of keeping warm while seeking to meet net Zero (Carbon) targets in the next few years. It will mean significant changes for all of us, not least in our attitudes and expectations.
