This Sunday is the last before Ascension, also the one near to Rogation Days. On Thursday we celebrate that final 'Goodbye' between the first disciples and their experience of the physical presence of the risen Jesus; then next Sunday is the last of the Easter season before we celebrate the birthday of the Church at Pentecost/Whitsun the following week. Between Ascension and Pentecost, we are joining with:

Thy Kingdom Come 2024: 9th May (Ascension Day) – 19th May (Pentecost)

This global ecumenical prayer movement invites Christians around the world to pray, from Ascension to Pentecost, for more people to come to know Jesus. Starting small in May 2016 TKC has grown into a movement which unites more than a million Christians in prayer, in nearly 90% of countries worldwide, across 85 different denominations and traditions - so that friends and family, neighbours and colleagues might come to faith in Jesus Christ. In the spirit of the movement, I invite any, and all, readers of this Newsletter to join, in whatever way works for them/you, to pray during the 11 days.
