As we reach the feast of Pentecost this Sunday, 'Thy Kingdom Come' prayers culminate in the last-but-one of the great festivals of the Church year as we remember what is, in effect, the birthday of the Church. There will be cake after the Sunday services!

We have been celebrating and commemorating the life and ministry of Jesus from Christmas through Easter, Ascension and now Pentecost. Next week, Trinity Sunday, brings all of that together in the first Sunday of Ordinary Time which we start by spending time once again with the central mystery of our faith - even more mysterious than the Resurrection.
