NEWS FROM EVERTON

Notice Board that used to be part of the Parish Council responsibility (next to the Pub in Everton) is being renovated. We are hugely grateful to those helping to make this happen; work is begun, but there is plenty yet to do.

Churchyard please be in touch with Hilary or Jane Butcher if you can help with taming the wilderness. There is a churchyard plan which has not been widely circulated nor acted on for lack of personnel this year. We have had some complaints and need some matching offers of help. We are applying to the Council to see if any of their volunteers are willing to help in the churchyard, watch this space and Social Media for working party arrangements. The work will involve taking down and then keeping down areas designated for mowing - which includes all paths and path edges, the 'spring cut' area that has got away now due to wet and inclement weather and should have been cut at the end of May, and areas around the current graves to the north side of the church. NB Working parties will be offered refreshments - so offers of help with that are also welcome!

Finance - as expected, making ends meet is a challenge this year. Thank you to those who are supporting the church financially; the Treasurer and PCC are planning an information drive later in the year (towards Harvest and Gift Day) but any contributions to running costs now would be very welcome.

The final total for **Everton Christian Aid collection** was £105.

Soup and Social organised by Everton Community Volunteers at the Church Hall was again well attended and well-received this week, with some 26 guests who were service a choice of 4 soups with bread to accompany, cake to follow and tea and coffee as required.
