St Denis Churchyard - volunteers group, a task group of Gamlingay with the Hatleys PCC, is planning Autumn work in the churchyard. Advice is being sought from Cambs Wildlife Trust on possible future (next Autumn) dredging of the ancient moat which borders the churchyard on two sides. Tree management is also being planned as well as managing the hedges which are encroaching on the churchyard. A number of dead elms will need removing for safety.

The Spindle trees in the churchyard look spectacular this year - the red is fruit rather than flowers.



Remembrance for the Hatley dead from two world wars will take place both at Gamlingay and, if anyone wishes, privately in Hatley St George church, where there is also a memorial with the names which will be read at the Gamlingay civic ceremony.
