To be considered for the vacancy you must be:

- aged 18 or over
- an elector
- a resident or worker based within three miles of the Parish during the past year

Please contact the Parish Clerk for more information about the role or to request an application form. Candidates must submit a completed application form to the Parish Clerk **no later than 5pm on Monday 10th March 2025**.

All candidates will be expected to **attend the Parish Council Meeting due to be held at 7.00pm on Tuesday 18th March 2025 in Hatley Village Hall**, where all applications will be formally received and considered by the Parish Council. The meeting may temporarily close to the public while the Parish Council reaches a decision to co-opt a new member. We look forward to hearing from you.
