This Sunday 2nd March, the last before Lent (Quinquegesima), expands on last week's theme of God's power in creation by focusing on the glory of God. This is seen in the account of the transfiguration of Jesus witnessed by the disciples, alongside the story of Moses whose face shines from his encounter with God.

Children and Families material will look at the story of how Jesus is seen by his disciples briefly in his glory on the mountaintop before he goes to his death. This account prepares for Lent where Christians take time to look at their lives in the light of the fasting and temptations of Jesus (these are next week's theme).


